ADMISSION NOTICE

Applications are invited for admission to the MPS programme of the Institute with Government of India Fellowship for the academic session 2017-2018 to commence from 11th July, 2017:

MASTER OF POPULATION STUDIES (M.P.S.)

No. of Seats: 50 Seats with Govt. of India fellowship.

Eligibility: Master's degree in social science (Economics, Sociology, Psychology, Geography, Anthropology, Social Work etc.) and Mathematics and Statistics from a recognized university in India or abroad with a minimum of 55% of aggregate marks in all subjects (all semesters/parts included) are eligible to apply. Candidates awaiting results of qualifying examination latest by 30th September 2017 can also apply for consideration. The upper age limit is 28 years as on 30.6.2017. Marks and age are relaxable for candidates belonging to reserved categories and women as per GOI rules.

<u>Duration</u>: One year (Full-Time)

<u>Fellowship</u>: Each selected Indian student will be awarded a Government of India fellowship @ Rs.5,000/per month.

Selection Criteria: The admission to MPS course is through a two-stage process. The Online Entrance Test will be a qualifying test, and that will compose of objective type questions of multiple choice. The syllabus of Entrance Test shall consist of basic general knowledge, logical reasoning, English grammar, basic mathematics, population, health and social science. The test venue will be notified in the Admit Card. Based on the performance in the Online Test, shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview at IIPS around the third week of June 2017. Shortlisted candidates appearing for the interview are entitled to claim sleeper class train fare by the shortest route on production of original tickets and in case of road journey, normal fare will be paid only for travel by public transport run by a Government body.

Reservation: Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD & Women candidates will be considered as per the Government of India norms.

Sponsorship: Officials can also be sponsored by Government departments, research institutions, universities, medical colleges and non-governmental organisations to be considered for admission. However, the selection will be made as per selection criteria.

Eligible foreign candidates can also apply for admission provided they secure financial support from any outside agency. Processing fee will not be charged from the foreign candidates while submission of completed application forms. Also, admission test will not be conducted for the foreign candidates and that the admission will be offered directly if the candidates fulfil the eligibility criteria of the Institute.

<u>Fees</u>: Refer to IIPS website for course-wise fee schedule. If any student desires to withdraw admission after paying the course fee, the refund of course will be as per the UGC rules.

<u>Registration for Admission Test</u>: All eligible candidates are required to register online by visiting the Institute's website <u>www.iipsindia.org</u> during <u>31.03.2017</u> to <u>01.05.2017</u>. Those interested in applying for more than one course should pay application processing fee separately for each course.

Only those candidates who have already passed the qualifying degree examinations and those who have already appeared/ shall be appearing in the final qualifying examinations, before the conduct of entrance test, are eligible to apply.
