

TRAVEL GRANT APPLICATION

The International Institute for Population Sciences (IIPS), Mumbai in collaboration with the UCSD Center on Gender Equity and Health is seeking applications for the award of Travel Grants to candidates having strong work experience in the field of Gender and Health and experience working with large-scale data.

The grants are available to PhD students/junior faculty whose work has been accepted for presentation at a conference with the following prerequisites:

- must be registered as a PhD student/junior faculty at IIPS
- when no other source of funding/partial funding is available;
- the accepted paper is in the field of gender and health;
- the recipient must acknowledge during the presentation/publication that they received a travel grant from this project for attending the conference

Interested applicants are requested to send a cover letter along with the following:

- Updated curriculum vitae;
- Name of Conference, Location, date and Title of presentation;
- Copy of letter notifying that work has been accepted for presentation;
- Cover letter stating background, interest in the field of gender and health, purpose of presenting at the conference and future goals;
- List/Link of publications;
- Short statement from the faculty advisor in support of the presentation.

The application material may be submitted as and when the applicant receives an intimation that s/he is not getting financial support or getting partial financial support from the conference organizers/other funding agencies. Ideally, the applicants must submit application material well in advance. The application material must be emailed (as one document) to iipsgehproject@iips.net

There is a provision of five grants of USD 600.00 each during the period November 2018 to October 2019. However, the project coordinators have the right to decrease the number of grants and increase the amount depending upon the request received and the merit thereof.
