\*It is decided by IIPS to encourage poster presentation by students/research scholars and made provision of three awards for this purpose in each day of the seminar. One presenting author of the best Poster will get reward of Rs. 10000/-, the second best Poster will get reward of Rs. 7000/-, and third best Poster will get reward of Rs. 5000/-. Abstracts were selected keeping in view this criterion. The selection committee selected good papers for the Poster presentation instead of keeping them in Oral session to make them more visible and having more time for face to face meeting and discussion with delegates.
